Olya's reported cases include:

- *Fresh'N'Clean (Wales) Ltd (In Liquidation) v Miah and others* LTL 3/10/2006 - Defending a company director in a claim for dishonest assistance in a case of VAT carousel fraud.
 - *Saunders v Garrett* [2005] WTLR 749 - Successfully defending a claim by a same-sex partner of the deceased under the Inheritance (Provision for Family and Dependents) Act 1975. Construction of s.1(1)(ba) of the 1975 Act in an ECHR-compliant way: article 8 ECHR brought into play article 14 but Article 1 of the First Protocol was not engaged.
 - *Manolakaki v Constantinides and Lange* [2004] EWHC 749 - Defending a solicitor in a professional negligence claim and pursuing a claim against his professional indemnity insurers who had refused to indemnify him on the grounds of dishonesty in a US\$1m financial instrument fraud.
