### While supervised by [James MacDougald](#):

- Writing opinions on inheritance tax issues, including qualifying interests in possession, exemption for property given to charity and analysis of the tax effect of a disclaimed gift.
- Advice on an application under the Variation of Trusts Act 1958.
- Assisted on settling particulars of claim for a proprietary estoppel claim.

### While supervised by [Jeremy Callman](#):

- A GP Partnership dispute, involving issues around whether the practice buildings were partnership property, and a claim for the rental profits of those buildings. Boris assisted with drafting particulars of claim and on costs budgeting issues before the CCMC.
- Drafting a defence to a commercial partnership claim, involving limitation and delay.
- A company dispute, including drafting an unfair prejudice petition and applying for interim relief.

Boris has also observed hearings including *HMRC v The Boston Consulting Group* [2026] UKUT 00025, and a three-day TOLATA trial in the County Court.

Before pupillage, Boris worked as a solicitor's agent and has experience of possession claims in the County Court.
